In December 2022, she completed the requirements to become a licensed massage therapist in the state of WI, adding yet another healing modality to her offerings.

Her life is deeply influenced by ancient ancestral medicine and her practice includes a deep reverence for Mother Earth and all of her blessings.



She is a life-student of the technologies that our ancestors used for their natural healing and well-being including plant medicine, sound healing and Curanderismo, passed down from her grandmother in her physical and spirit form.

Her experiences have enriched, challenged and added depth on her journey to wholeness. It is her hope that through the sharing of her experiences and knowledge, it will help others realize their own personal paths to wholeness.
